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TOUR CHANGES

Due to the economic climate in Barbados I regret that the Villa accommodation offered before Christmas is no longer available. We have therefore transferred all the villa bookings into the one bedroom apartments at All Seasons Europa sleeping two or three adults. Rooming arrangements can be made later. If you have any concerns or wish to discuss this further please do not hesitate to contact me on either telephone numbers above. Sharing will only be offered if you have indicated that you are willing to share.



INSURANCE

One of the benefits of travelling in a large group is that travel insurance can be a lot cheaper. Barbados is classified as a long haul destination, and can attract the more expensive rates of insurance. The current price for 10-17 days cover is £58.00. We can offer the same cover but on a group policy for a lot cheaper. If you are interested then please let me know as soon as possible. You may of course already be covered by your own policy. We cannot stress too strongly the need for insurance when travelling. Barbados has no NHS and a simple visit to the doctors can cost £35 plus without any treatment. Not to mention cover for other losses, baggage, money, cancellation etc.

Special family rates are available for those travelling with children please contact me for prices.

FINAL HOLIDAY PRICE

We can now confirm that the final holiday price per person will be £895.00 this includes return flights on Virgin Atlantic, 14 nights self catering accommodation at the All Seasons Resort Europa on the Gold Coast of the Island. Transfers too and from the resort, entrance to the Virgin Lounge at London Gatwick on the day of departure, and the services of the Virgin Holiday representatives are also included. Upgrade of flights to premium economy are available at an extra cost of £569.00 return. Seats are limited so please let me know if you wish to book.

Banks & Money Matters



Banks are open from 8.00am until 3.00pm Monday to Thursday and 8.00am until 5.00pm on Fridays. The Caribbean Commercial Bank is located in Bridgetown, Hastings, Christchurch, **Sunset Crest** (the nearest branch to our complex). and opens on Saturday mornings from 9.00am until 12.00 midday.

The Barbados National Bank at the airport is open from 8.00am until the last plane leaves or arrives 7 days a week including holidays. Any Barbadian currency you may have left can be changed there.

The Barbados dollar is directly tied to the United States dollar at a rate of US\$1=Bds\$1.98. You are advised to take US dollar travellers cheques.

All purchases made on credit cards will appear in Barbados dollars. There are some ATM machines on the Island that will give you cash 24 hours.

BE CAREFUL A lot of outlets (restaurants in particular) find it fashionable to quote prices in US dollars. Check when prices are quoted . Are they American or Barbados? You could end up paying double!

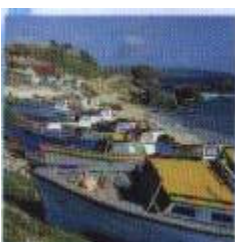
There will be cricket clothing on sale for those playing matches. Please see the tour kit manager, **Callum Steel** for further details.

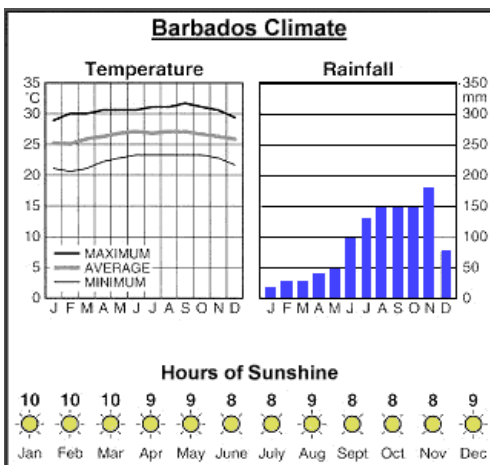




Car Hire

Arrangements are well in hand regarding car hire. Prices seem to be quite competitive and I will report back in future newsletters with prices. You are reminded that making your booking here in the UK **before** we leave is a lot cheaper than booking when you arrive. All car hire is paid for on collection of the vehicle at the resort. You pay nothing when you make the booking.

Weather



As you can see from the illustration the weather in Barbados is quite temperate.

With a maximum of eight hours of sunshine a day. Being so close to the equator sunsets are quite fast and can be spectacular. Rainfall as shown can reach 150mm in October. I can tell you it will rain over the two weeks but hopefully not too much during the day. An average temperature of 27°C is expected. Please note that too much sun too soon can and will ruin your holiday. We would advise a high factor sun screen for the first few days. Only you know how much you can sit in the sun.

Passports



I am reminding you once again to check your passport. Where is it? Is it in date? Remember it must be valid for at least 3 months after your return. Holders of non European passports may need a visa I have the relevant forms therefore if this applies to you please contact me ASAP. Visa applications can take 6 weeks to process
